VENUE:-

- This summer camp is for the classes (1 to 8)
- Events which will be conducted are as follows:-
 - ❖ SPORTS (Volleyball, Basketball and football, Karate)
 - ❖ MUSIC (Guitar, Keyboard, Drums)
 - ❖ Dance (Classical, Western, Folk , Contemporary.)
 - ❖ Computer (Java programming, web page designing, Word, Excel , PowerPoint)
 - ❖ Painting , Drawing and Craft.
 - ❖ English Creative Writing.
- All this will be taught in the school Shastripuram as well as in Sunari Branch.
- Camp will start from 20th May till 4th of June.

Note:- English Creative writing , computers , volleyball , football and Karate will be held at sunari.

Basketball, Music, Dance and Painting, Drawing and craft will be held at shastripuram.

Timings:-

- SPORTS – Timings for sports events will be of 2 hours. Starting from 7:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.
- MUSIC – 1 hour each will be given to every instrument.
 - ❖ Guitar- 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.
 - ❖ Keyboard – 8:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.
 - ❖ Drums – 9:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.
- DANCE- Dance will be of 2 hours.
- COMPUTER - Timing will be of 2 hours. Starting from 7:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.

CREATIVE WRITING:-

Introduction

Creative writing is any writing that goes outside the bounds of normal professional, journalistic, academic, or technical forms of literature, typically identified by an emphasis on *narrative craft*, *character development*, and *the use of literary tropes or with various traditions of poetry and poetics*.

Skills Offered

The Creative Writing Workshop will offer theoretical knowledge and practical application of various aspects of:-

1. Novel & Short Story Writing

- Novel and short story writing in first and third person perspectives, with pros and cons of both
- Theme selection and Plot development
- World building and Character development
- Setting and description of scenes and actions with effective tricks for holding the reader's attention
- Use of popular tropes and avoidance of clichés

2. Composing Poetry

- Introduction to elements of poetry, like *voice, diction, imagery, figures of speech, symbolism and allegory, syntax, sound, rhythm and meter, and structure.*
- Instruction on their use in composing poems
- Activities and group discussions to familiarise the participants with the use of these elements
- Beginner level instruction in poetry composition
- Guidance on referencing different poets and poems for inspiration on composing poems

Takeaways

After attending this Creative Writing Workshop, the participants will be able to:

1. Come up with one or more ideas for developing their own novel blueprint
2. Understand how to begin with writing a novel or fiction based short story
3. Gain the ability to analyse and use different tropes in writing fiction
4. Understand the different elements that commonly go into the composition of a poem
5. Learn to compose poems with or without using those elements, i.e. traditional and/or norm-breaking poetry composition
6. Become comfortable with expressing their thoughts, feelings and ideas in writing much more proficiently

Guidelines

1. The Creative Writing Workshop will be organised at the school campus for the duration of the Summer Camp.
2. The timings will be from 7:30 am to 9:30 am (this may change based on the final decision of the school administration)
3. The fee charged for the workshop will be Rs.700/-
4. All participants will be provided with access to digital resources, including class notes, online reference material, etc.
5. Participants are expected to bring a printout of the [TheoryForCreativeWritingWorkshop.pdf](#) document with them for all the classes.
6. Participants are required to carry a notebook and necessary stationery to take down additional notes.
7. Some activities and assignments will be allotted after every session and all participants must compulsorily participate and complete them for the purpose of gaining hands-on practical experience.
