The Indian National song VANDE MATARAM

The song Vande Mataram composed in Sanskrit by Bankim Chandra Chatterjee was a source of inspiration to the people in their struggle for freedom the first political occasion when it was sung was the 1896 session of the Indian national Congress the song first appeared in his book 'Anandmatha' published in 1882 amid fears of a ban by the British Raj, through the song itself was actually written 6 years prior in 1876.

- A pupil seeking admission must produce the Date of Birth Certificate issued by the concerned govt. authorities along with the Transfer Certificate if appliable.
- Irrespective of the time of admission, fee will be charged from the beginning of the academic session.
- All documents, once submitted, become the property of the school and are not returned.

WITHDRAWAL

- The application for Transfer Certificate should be made in writing by the parent or guardian along with prescribed fee.
- 2. One full academic session must be completed for obtaining a T.C.
- 3. A month's notice in writing is required before a student can be withdrawn; in lieu of such a notice, an additional fee of one month may be deposited. No such notice is acceptable during the school vacation; and in case of a withdrawal at this time, the fees must be paid up to the end of the term.
- No Transfer Certificate or any other Certificate will be issued if there are dues pending.

RULES AND DISCIPLINE

- Irregular attendance at school, habitual laziness, disobedience, objectionable moral influence, intentional discourtesy or disrespect to teachers, are each sufficient cause for dismissal.
- Any student who is found to have done damage of any kind in the class room or anywhere in the premises of the School has to make good the damage done.
- All should be particularly careful to avoid throwing of food, papers etc. anywhere in the School premises except in the bins provided for the purpose.
- 4. No late arrival to School may be admitted to class without the Principal's or PTI's signature on the late attendance Record page in the School Dairy. The teachers will also sign the Absence Record Page before admitting the pupil to class.
- 5. No pupil may leave the School premises during school hours (recess time included) without the written permission from the Principal.
- 6. The School is not responsible for the loss of books, pens, money etc. Each student is responsible for his/her things.
- It is not advisable to bring valuable articles like watches, Gold/silver ornaments, etc
- 8. Each student's belongings must be marked, as far as possible, with the owner's name for easy identification.
- 9. Students are not allowed to bring mobile phones and any valuable items to school.
- 10. Books & copies must be properly covered and not torn out.

SYLLABUS / EXAMINATION / PROMOTION

 Besides the Terminal Examinations there are other Tests during the year. Report on conduct, application and progress and attendance are furnished from time to time to the parents/guardians to keep them informed about the performance of their children in School.

- Pupil absent from the Examination or Test for any reason, is not reexamined, and loses the marks. If they are absent without grave reasonsor previous written permission they will be regarded as having failed.
- 3. If a pupil does not have 75% of attendance she/he will not allowed to write exam and not be considered for promotion.
- The Progress Report/Result will be shown only to the parents or guardians after every Term examination; it can be withheld for non-payment of school dues.
- Failure in or absence from a subject excludes the student from being reckoned for the order of merit.
- 6. Taking all the term exams is compulsory for promotion.
- 7. There is no provision for Re-examination or promotion on trial.
- 8. No examination will be postponed or anticipated for any student.
- 9. There is no double promotion to any student to any class.
- For Promotion, a student has to obtain clear pass in major subjects.
 Pass percentage for students Kindergarten: 50% Class I & Above: 41%

The academic year is divided into two terms. Students are evaluated through formal assessments as well as through their day performance under the Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE). Formal assessments are held at the end of each term. Four formal assessments are conducted in the academic session:

- Unit Test-1 (UT 1) included the entire syllabus covered till the test date.
- Half yearly Examination (HE) is cumulative in nature and includes the entire syllabus of Term -1.
- Unit Test-2 (UT 2) includes the syllabus covered post term-1 till the test date.
- Annual Examination (AE) is cumulative in nature and will be based on selected portion from Term -1 and the entire syllabus of Term -2.

FEE RULES

- 1. School fees are to be paid for full year, i.e for all twelve months.
- 2. All fees to be remitted at the SCHOOL ONLINE PAYMENT PORTAL or at Canara Bank, Shastripuram branch.
- 3. No fee transaction will be accepted in the school either as cash or cheque.
- 4. Parents should retain the receipts issued to them, and produce them as proof of payment if and when needed.
- 5. The fees must be paid for the months in which the pupil's name has been carried on in the attendance register, even if he/she has been absent.
- 6. The Term Fee (Quarterly fee) has to be paid in full, even if the pupil leaves before the Term is over.
- 7. Students whose fees fall into arrears are liable to be debarred from taking the exams and attending school; neither their Report Cards nor Transfer Certificates will be issued till all accounts are fully settled.
- 8. The fees for the vacation months are to be paid in advance.
- 9. No reduction in fees is made on account of Summer and Winter holidays or other vacations or temporary absence.
- 10. No concession in fees is entertained for two or more children coming from the same family.
- 11. School fees are calculated for a twelve month cycle.
- 12. All certificates other than T.C. and Migration Certificate can be had for minimum Rs.100/- each per certificate.
- 13. The fees may be paid in advance for the whole year or for a quarter. If not paid in advance, the fees of the running quarter will have to be paid before the end of the first month of that quarter after which a fine of Rs.300/-will be levied for late payment for each passing month.
- 14. There will be proportionate increment in the fees every year as per the UP Self-financed independent school (Fee Regulatory) Act 2018.
- Annual composite fee is an all-inclusive fee except exam fee.

PUNCTUALITY AND ATTENDANCE

- 1. Regularity in attendance is most essential. The minimum requirement of attendance is 75%.
- 2. Attendance is compulsory on the first and last working day of every term.
- 3. Students must report to school on time. School gates are closed five minutes after the bell.
- 4. Parents should fill the school leave record for each day the student is absent from school stating the reason for absence.
- 5. No student who has been absent on the previous day will be admitted to the class without the filled leave record signed
- Students are not allowed to go home once they come to the school in the morning. Appointment with doctors or any social engagements must not be arranged during school hours. No partial attendance will be permitted.
- 7. No student is permitted to leave school before time except on emergency health issues and other family exigencies, students will not be sent with anyone else other than parents, unless an application to the contrary with adequate identify proof by the parents, is submitted
- 8. If a student continues to be absent for a month without the previous written permission of the Principal, his/ her name will be struck off from the roll. In case of re-admission, all the fees will be charged afresh.
- Repeated absence without leave or unexplained absence for more than six consecutive days renders the student liable to have his/her name struck off the rolls. Re-admission may be granted only after payment of a re-admission fee at the discretion of the Principal.
- 10. The student who does not rejoin the school within three days after the commencement of a Term or a major vacation shall be removed from the rolls unless leave has been previously applied for and sanctioned by the principal. An absentee will be charged Rs.100/- per day of absence.
- 11. Marriage, Tours, Family function, etc. and any pre-planned programme, you are recommended to submit a leave application in advance in a separate paper other than school diary.
- 12. In case of absence for more than three days on medical grounds, a medical-certificate must be produced. The medical certificate should bear the rubber stamp of the doctor with the registration number. In case if necessary, the school has the right to have the child re-examined by a doctor acceptable to the school.

Summer: White shirt with red check border, Red trousers for the boys and skirt for the girls. Red socks and red, blue & black customized shoes.

Winter: Grey checked full pants and white shirt with black border and red jacket with hoodie, red socks and red & black shoes for both boys and girls.

(Summer) Full length black trousers for Boys and Girls. Rest of the uniform pattern will be same as the above of Class 1



SCHOOL UNIFORM PATTERN (GIRLS)





COOPERATION FROM PARENTS

- 1. Please read and understand the contents of this diary and doubts (if any) can be cleared from the school.
- 2. These Rules and Regulations are laid down in the best interest of your child. Kindly read them and assist your child to observe them diligently.
- Give your whole-hearted and willing cooperation in all matters pertaining to the education of your child. Please abide by the judgment and decision of the Principal and Staff.
- 4. Supervise your child's studies at home; send him/her to school regularly. And help him/her to maintain school work neatly.
- Do look for the occasional reports, comments and complaints from teachers entered in the diary of your child; sign them as proof that you have seen them; and also sign other relevant documents when required.
- Parents are allowed in school only when called or during the Parentteachers meet (PTMs).
- 7. In matters of evaluating the answer sheets and the annual promotions, the opinion of the Principal and the staff is binding. No re-evaluation of answer papers and reconsideration of promotions.
- 8. Answer sheets of the First Term Examination will be shown to you for

- 11. Children are your wealth; students are our pride. As you love and care for them, so do we, and intend the best for them. Hence we the staff and parents should have mutual trust and confidence. Never let sparks turn into fire.
- 12. Very often students bring to school such items that have nothing to do with studies. Parents must prevent the children from bringing such things to the school. Please do not expect the Principal and the staff to do what the parents are supposed to do.

- 13. It is matter of deep concern that parents send children suffering from infectious ailments to attend classes or examinations. Such conduct would lead to an epidemic like situation in the school. Take note of the quarantine period recommended for a few different infectious ailments: Chicken pox -three weeks.
 - Measles and mumps -two weeks
 - Conjunctivitis -one week.
- 14. Late arrival in the school and leave of absence should be informed in writing.
- 15. No gifts to staff and students in the name of birthday celebrations. Please keep this to the lowest key possible. Parents must refrain from sending gifts to teachers on any occasion.
- 16. Send only home cooked traditional food as tiffin to children. No fast food and junk food allowed in the school. No lunch boxes should be sent during the school time.
- 17. School will not provide any conveyance and will not have any responsibility on any eventuality.
- 18. Students are not allowed to come to school riding bicycles/ two wheelers without the explicit permission of the principal.
- 19. Students' cycle must be locked and parked in the cycle stand.
- 20. Students are not allowed to drive scooters/motorcycles/cars while commuting to and from the school.
- 21. Parents should ensure that their ward report to school before the morning assembly begins and pick up the child only after the school hours are over. No cars or any other mode of transport will be permitted to be parked in front of the school gates.
- 22. Please check the diary each day for entries from the school and also use the diary for any communication with the school.
- 23. Ensure strict adherence to the prescribed uniforms, cleanliness and personal hygine of your ward.
- 24. See that all required text/note books and stationary are carried each day to the school as per time table.
- 25. Check if homework or other assignments are completed as required.
- 26. Parents should furnish to school their latest office and residential addresses and telephone numbers. These are vital in the interest of the safety of the student.
- 27. No money is to be given for events organised by the school unless asked through circular.

- 28. Parents of the Nursery, lower KG and upper KG must write the names of their wards on their belongings with a permanent marker. They should also send an extra set of clothes in their bags to be used in case of emergency.
- 29. Under no circumstances parents are allowed to directly walk to the classrooms. They need to have prior appointment for any genuine reasons to meet the teachers only in the visitors lounge.
- 30. Experience has shown that many parents are indifferent to the progress, welfare and discipline of wards, and in many cases awareness comes much too late, proving that home-school interaction is most vital. To fulfill this, Parents Teacher Meetings (PTM) are organized from time to time. Parents are advised to attend all PTM and contribute to the well-being of their wards.
- 31. The name of the student, class and section must be marked on all personal belongings to facilitate recovery if lost in the school premises.
- 32. The school strongly discourages private tuitions. The teaching program in the school is good enough for the students to perform well, provided they are attentive in the class and realize their responsibilities. The habit of self-study and regularity in reading must be encouraged at home.
- 33. Parents should keep in mind as co-educators of the child, it is very essential to observe the dress code when they are in the school premises. Pedal-pushers, Bermuda shorts or any tight fitting or suggestive clothing could be a source of distraction or deviation from the normal dress code. Public with indecent and inappropriate dress code will not be permitted in the school premises.
- 34. Healthy and nutritious food should be packed for tiffin along with a napkin.

GUIDELINES FOR THE STUDENTS

Dear Students:

- a) Be polite and courteous everywhere.
 - b) Be honest and truthful, and stand for values whatever be the cost.
 - c) Accept cheerfully whatever responsibility is given, and face difficulties with courage and determination.
 - d) Take part in games with true sportsman spirit.
 - e) Greet your parents, teachers and elders whenever you meet them.
- Strict regularity, implicit obedience, courtesy in speech and conduct, and cleanliness of dress and person, are expected from every pupil. Students must strictly conform to the regulations laid down in this regard.

- 3. You are responsible for your conduct not only in the school, but also outside. Any objectionable conduct outside the school makes you liable for disciplinary action, because such conduct would endanger the good name of the school.
- Any kind of damage done to the school property must be made/ compensated.
- 5. Gifts to the members of the staff, or other expressions in their honour, are not allowed.
- 6. All of you must possess a copy of the school diary and it is to be brought to the school on all working days.
- 7. Late-comers and absentees will not be admitted without a proper explanation in writing from the parents.
- 8. Leave of Absence will be granted for genuine reasons if applied by the parents in advance.
- 9. Fines will be imposed by the Principal or the staff for irregularity, indiscipline, damage to the school property, improper uniform etc.
- 10. Irregular attendance, insubordination, bad conduct, habitual lack of interest, behavior deterimental to the discipline and the moral tone of the school, repeated failure in tests or examinations, are sufficient reasons, singly or collectively, for expulsion from the school.
- 11. School holds no responsibility for the loss of money, books, articles of clothing, or other valuables in the school.
- 12. Lost and found articles are to be deposited in the office.
- 13. Birthday celebrations should be restricted to your section only and to the minimum show.
- 14. Bring along the tiffin while coming to school in the morning; we will not accept tiffin brought during the school hours.

EXPULSION FROM SCHOOL

Irregularity, careless and untidy work in academics, lack of punctuality, failure of the student to be in proper school uniform consistently, any act of misconduct or bad behavior and/ or dissatisfactory performance may lead to suspension from school for a period of time depending on the degree of nonconformance. Repeated non-conformance may lead to rustication from the school. Anecdotal records of students are maintained by the school. The non-compliance, non-cooperative and quarrelsome attitude of the parents towards the school management and faculty is a valid reason for rustication of their ward/s from the school.

RULES OF LIBRARY

- 1. The student must maintain silence in the library.
- Every student will hold one card which is not transferable. A book may be issued for one week at a time but the students should return the book within a week; otherwise a fine is levied.
- 3. Duplicate card will not be issued on a payment of Rs. 50/-
- 4. Every student should return the card before the session ends.
- 5. A book can be re issued only once.
- 6. Every class has a day on which the books will be issued; it is compulsory for every student to read books from library.
- 7. Students can return the book during library period and students who want to borrow a book should fill up the entries on their cards and leave them with the librarian. They can collect the book from the library during the library period. There will be an overdue charge of rupees 1/- per day per book if a book is kept longer than the specified period.
- 8. The loss or damage to the book will be realized along with the special fine.
- 9. Only one volume can be borrowed at a time. Periodicals and reference books are not issued.
- 10. Books taken for home must be returned on the date within two weeks otherwise Rs. 5/- per day will have to be paid until the cost of book is realized.
- 11. Books scribbled upon, torn or otherwise damaged, defaced or lost must be paid for at a rate to be determined by the librarian.
- 12. Student who takes TC from the school is requested to clear his/her library dues in time and return all books the above regulations are made to make the working of the library successful for the benefit of the students.
- 13. Books issued should be returned before the final exam.
- 14. Every student is expected to strictly follow the guidelines given by the librarian.

NORMS OF DISCIPLINE
