INTRODUCTION & GENERAL INFORMATION

THE ROMAN CATHOLIC DIOCESE OF AGRA EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY, Agra- has been upbeat to initiate and start one more self-financed Christian Minority Institution under the article 30(1) of the Indian Constitution, with the name St. Thomas' School at Sector C-1, Shastripuram, Agra, 282007 with a profile motto, **"Lead Kindly Light"**. **Lord Jesus Christ said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will have the light of life and will never walk in darkness."** (The Holy Bible). We believe each student is unique. Each one has a different pace of learning, which needs to be discovered by the school. Therefore St. Thomas' School strives to understand and fulfil the individual need of the learners. We have an education system that builds the learners' character and empower them in all

aspects- intellectual, physical, emotional, spiritual and social.

A SHORT HISTORY

With view of extending its quality education services to the students of Sikandra and Shastripuram, Agra, Roman Catholic Diocese of Agra began the school in April, 2014. It was blessed and inaugurated by most Rev. Dr. Albert D'Souza, Archbishop of Agra. Rev. Fr. Arun Lasrado was the first principal and Late Rev. Fr. Joe Vadakekkara, as the manager. The school began with LKG and UKG in that year. Every year school is growing with one more class and will be upgraded to senior secondary level. The extension of the school has taken place in the year 2020 and a new spacious school campus has come up at Sunari Village, just the outskirts of the city. The impressive upcoming school building at the large campus will be surrounded by lush green lawns and foliage, and has good and wide roads.



OUR VISION AND MISSION

We consider school is a powerful agent in forming human beings to bring about just society. The aim of the school is to create individuals who are intellectually competent, morally sound, psychologically whole, imbued with the sense of the divine, committed to the cause of Justice, love and peace, and ever open to further growth.

AFFILIATION:

The school is recognized by the state administration presently for providing education to the students in the elementary level. The school will get affiliated to any one Central education board based in New Delhi under whose edges the board exams will be conducted. (As per the regulations of the New Education policy 2020)



ADMISSION POLICY : LKG (2021 – 2022 SESSIONS)

Every child has right to have quality education and we make no discrimination on the basis of caste, creed, sex, economic status or social status. However, we can admit only as many as we can. This is a co-educational institution keeping 50% seats both boys and girls i.e. upholding gender equality as far as possible.

Prospectus and registration form for admission to LKG will be available through online/offline. Child who has completed 3.9 years to 4.8 years as on 1st April 2021 can apply for admission in the current academic year. (Born between August, 2016 and July, 2017).

Parents seeking admission of their wards in LKG must register their ward's name online and submit duly filled registration form in the school office on the said date and time. Dates for the verifications will be allotted to each child at the time of submitting the duly completed registration form. On the allotted dates for verification, the parents will come with the child. If there are more number of candidates (more than the available seats) found eligible for admission after the verification, then the required number will be finalized by draw of lots. The list of the selected students will be displayed on the school notice board/website and their parents will be given time to deposit admission fees and complete other formalities. Only the parent of the child and no other relatives will be able to complete the admission formalities.

If the parent, whose child's name is there in the admission list, is unable to complete the formalities within the given dates will forfeit the chance for the admission. Fee once paid at the time of admission is non-refundable in case of withdrawal. The management is not responsible for any unauthorized persons or activities in the name of the admission. Date of birth once registered cannot be altered. [(as per U.P.G.O. No. 1101/1(5)].

It must be very clear that the parents who are seeking admission of their wards to L.K.G are fully aware of all the above conditions and have already read these conditions which were displayed on the school notice board/website much in advance. The Management reserves the right to have the last word in all matters related to admission.



MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

English is the primary medium of instruction in our school. However, Hindi is given importance as the local and national official language.

REMOVAL FROM SCHOOL

A child's place in school is subject to good behaviour and satisfactory work. The school expects its pupils to be obedient and courteous not only in the school but outside as well. Any objectionable conduct reported either inside or outside the school, is part of the pupils, then liable for disciplinary action. Repeated misconduct, cheating in examination or other offenses against honesty or morality will lead to the expulsion of Pupil. Repeated misconduct and non-cooperation from the parent is also a ground for expulsion from the school.

Academic year is divided into Two Term. There will be two Unit Tests, Mid – Term Exam (September), Final Exam (March). All dates are given in the student hand book / planner.

DETAILS OF THE FEE STRUCTURE

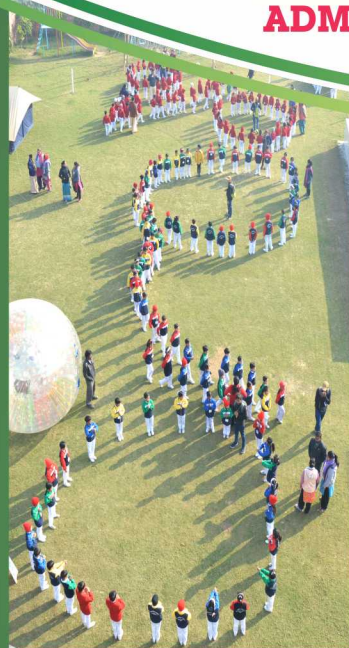
The details of fees for the previous year, current year and the ensuing year are given below. No child will be permitted to begin a new term unless all arrears due on his / her account have been cleared in full before the commencement of the new term. The fees will be deposited in the bank according to the dates mentioned in the fee book, failing to do so, the fine will be charged accordingly.

The fee will be collected quarterly in four instalments (UP self-financed school fixation act 2018, 3:3:a(i)). You are requested to remit the fees before 10th of the second month of the quarter. Every pupil will pay fees of 12 months. No reduction of fee is made on account of summer and winter holidays or other vacations or temporary absence.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Kindergarten:-

Summer: White shirt with red check border, Red trouser for the boys and skirt for the girls. Red socks and Black shoes.

Winter: grey pants and white shirt with red check border, Red sweater and red jacket, red socks and black shoes.

Class I and above:

Summer: Grey shirt Black with Grey strip trouser/skirt. Black with white strip tie, socks black with grey strip.

Winter: Grey full sleeve shirts with black and white strip borders. Grey woolen pants, V neck Red sweater, red blazer with red cap, red socks and black shoes.

P.T Dress: (Wednesday & Saturday)

House T- shirt, White Trouser/ Skirt and P.T. shoes.
